RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
5. No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of Rule 477 by the Judge.
6. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
7. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. An S.A.E. must be submitted with entries if a receipt is required. No numbers will be sent to Exhibitors prior to the Show. Competitors' numbers should be collected from the Secretary's Office on the Show Ground. Cheques and Postal Orders to be made payable to BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd. NO entries will be accepted over the telephone.
8. In **ALL Classes**, correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats, numbers All PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged.
BSPS SCOTLAND ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY ARISING FROM A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REGULATION. HAT CHECKS FOR COMPLIANCE WILL BE MADE.
9. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted or amended once received.
10. Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Scotland Spring Show 2019 may use the arenas for exercising.
11. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground.
12. On the day entries will be taken from 7.00am.

13. **Rule 67** - No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behaviour which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant matter to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS Handbook.
14. **Rule 70** – Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by them or assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. Family Member shall include a spouse or civil partner, a partner, a direct descendant or ascendant of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, brothers, sisters or adopted children of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, or any other person who is part of the same household as the Member or is in the reasonable opinion of the BSPS a member of the Member's family in the widest sense.
15. **The BSPS Scottish Branch/Board of Directors reserve the right to move, change, amalgamate or divide any class, championship or supreme as they deem fit when necessary to facilitate The running of the show. It is therefore the competitor's responsibility to keep up to date with any changes which may occur during the running of the show. Supreme of Show will be judged after all sections have been concluded.**

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR QUALIFIERS

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CLASSES

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2019 BSPS Championships Show to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners Open LR, FR, SP, NS and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in Classes Open Intermediate SRT (including Mixed height), W.H & SHT, CS and Heritage classes the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize winners in mixed height classes will qualify for the BSPS Championships provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 5 and 21 and ridden by a BSPS member.

RULE 5. *Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the BSPS are allowed 7 working days in which to become members and register their ponies. Please note this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications.*

RULE 21. *Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This Rule does not apply to classes with RIHS or Olympia qualification.*

THE BSPS CLASIC SECURITY (UK) LTD CHALLENGE

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Classic Security (UK) Ltd Challenge. Animals competing in the following Open Classes will qualify: - Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

THE BSPS PREMIER LEAGUE

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Premier League. Animals competing in the following classes will qualify: - Lead Rein, First Ridden, lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP Classes.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY 50TH YEAR GOLDEN ANNIVERSARY SHOW CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions the 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

THE BSPS THE WHITE COMPANY 50TH YEAR GOLDEN ANNIVERSARY SHOW CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS The White Company Mini WHP Champion of Champions the 1st prize winners in Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes will qualify.

THE BSPS BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES BEST RIDER

This show is a qualifier for the "Black Country Saddles Best Rider of the Year". The Best Rider in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead Rein Hunter Type, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms, Show Pony, the 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms and 153cms WHP, the Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter, Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes will receive a card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championship Show

THE ROYAL HIGHLAND SHOW – NURSERY STAKES

This show is a qualifier for The Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes 2019. The first 4 placed same pony and rider combination will qualify for the 2019 Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes provided they have jumped a clear round. Qualification will only move down the line to the next eligible pony and rider combination meeting the qualification criteria. This class is open to both BSPS Members and Non-Members.

BSHA CLASSES

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.**

Classes (36 - 42) are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

The three highest placed prize winners in all Open Affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show September 2019. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes).

The Association will award an Amateur Home-Produced rosette in all Affiliated **Open Cob** (Light & Heavyweight only) classes. These rosettes have been kindly sponsored by TSG, Mr L Turley. The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year.



Caledonian Showing Championships

The Caledonian Showing Championships are now well established in the showing calendar and will once again give 2019 competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. Evening Performances, loads of bling and razzmatazz ... everything an end of season Championship should have!

This year's show will be held at

Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 12/13 October 2019

This Show is a qualifier and every horse & pony placed 1st and 2nd in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse & Pony except for Adult/Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows and a wealth of other information.

BURGHLEY QUALIFIER - METHOD OF JUDGING
ALL SECTIONS TO BE RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BSPS RULES FOR
COMBINED TRAINING & GOLD CUP RULE BOOK
OPEN TO BSPS MEMBERS ONLY

Any SUITABLE BRIDLE, Boots and MARTINGALES ARE PERMITTED FOR WHP AND SHOW JUMPING
Competitors must compete in Sections A, B and C.

Marks attained in Section A – Dressage and Section B - WSP, shall be added together.

Any penalties incurred in Section C – Jumping will be deducted from the total of Section A and B.

The winner of the combined class will then be the one with the highest remaining score.

In the event of a tie or ties, the highest dressage score will determine the winner, if there is still equality
the highest WSP style mark will determine the winner.

Competitors must enter both Sections A and B to be eligible to go forward for Section C.

SECTION B – WORKING SPORTS PONY

Maximum Height of Fences – OPEN HEIGHT

The Course will consist of a mixture of Rustic WHP and Cross-Country style fences, water may be included.

Ponies will be awarded a Mark out of 10 for their gallop.

An elimination in this section will result in 150 points being deducted from the total score.

SECTION C – SHOW JUMPING

JUDGE: LESLIE SHIELDS - SCOTLAND

ANY SUITABLE BRIDLE. MARTINGALES ARE PERMITTED

This phase will be open to a percentage determined by entries in each class, gaining the highest amalgamated scores from Section A and B. In the event of elimination in Section C 100 penalty points will be deducted from the competitors score carried forward from Sections A, B and C.

The Jumping section will be judged on one round, over coloured and or rustic fences. There will be an optimum time for the course and penalties will be incurred for exceeding this time.

The competitor with the lowest amalgamated score from Sections A & B will jump first.

Mare or gelding 4 years old & over. Any height. Any type. Combination to be within their first 12 months of partnership.

CLASS 2 THE BSPTS MIXED HEIGHT CLASS FOR NOVICE SHOW PONIES

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exc 148cms. Competitors must be the right age for the height of pony they ride.

CLASS 3 THE BSPTS OPEN INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in current year.

CLASS 4 THE BSPTS OPEN SHOW PONY LEAD REIN

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

CLASS 5 THE BSPTS OPEN SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

THE BSPTS MINI SHOW PONY CHAMPIONSHIP
OPEN TO 1ST & 2ND PRIZEWINNERS FROM CLASSES 4 AND 5

CLASS 6 THE BSPTS OPEN SHOW PONIES

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exc 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 7 THE BSPTS OPEN SHOW PONIES

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exc 128cms and not exceeding 138cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 8 THE BSPTS OPEN SHOW PONIES

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exc 138cms and not exceeding 148cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 10 THE BSPS FIRST PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exc 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Snaffles bridles only. No cantering is allowed except in individual performance. Ponies must leave ring in walk or trot.

OPEN TO 1ST & 2ND PRIZEWINNERS FROM CLASSES 9 AND 10

CLASS 11 UNAFFILIATED TINY TOTS FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exc 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only. *Cantering in individual show is optional.* Open to SP, SHP & M&M ponies.

CLASS 12 THE BSPS MIXED HEIGHT CLASS FOR NOVICE SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 153cms. Competitors must be the correct age for the height of animal they ride. Class may be split if sufficient entries

CLASS 13 THE BSPS OPEN INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms, but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in current year.

THE BSPS OPEN INTERMEDIATE CHAMPIONSHIP
OPEN TO 1ST & 2ND PRIZEWINNERS FROM CLASS 3 AND 13

CLASS 14 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exc 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 15 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exc 122cms and not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 16 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exc 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 17 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exc 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.
