ALL CLASSES ARE OPEN TO MEMBERS & NON MEMBERS

Working Hunter Classes: For jumping classes level 3 body protectors (either 2009 or 2018) are required

Hats: Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. VG1, (BS)EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted.

Hat Tags are compulsory prior to entering the ring and will be available free of charge at the secretaries office. Please bring your hat to be tagged when you collect your number.

INDOOR ARENA - COMMENCING AT 9AM

TRAINING STAKES / WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

Animals will be required to jump a course of fences at the specified height. They will immediately be asked to give a short show including a change of rein in trot & canter. An extended canter / gallop may be shown but is not required. Lead Rein competitors must only show walk & trot.

*****LEVEL 3 BODY PROTECTORS (2009 or 2018) ARE COMPULSORY IN ALL WORKING HUNTER CLASSES FOR ALL AGES OF RIDERS. THIS INCLUDES WHEN WORKING IN OVER PRACTISE JUMPS*****

CLASS 1 Cross Poles Training Stakes

- Open to all types of Horses and Ponies 4 years and over.
- Lead Rein Competitors - No child under the age of 3 years may compete in any Lead Rein class. Lead Reins can enter this class but must not canter/gallop in their individual show. The leading rein must be attached to the noseband and not the bit.

CLASS 2 50cm Training Stakes

- Open to all types of Horses and Ponies 4 years and over. Riders any age over 5yrs
- Max height of fences 50cm.

CLASS 3 60cm Training Stakes

- Open to all types of Horses and Ponies 4 years and over. Riders any age over 5yrs.
- Max height of fences 60cm.

CLASS 4 70cm Training Stakes

- Open to all types of Horses and Ponies 4 years and over. Riders any age over 5yrs.
- Max height of fences 70cm.

CLASS 5 80cm Training Stakes

- Open to all types of Horses and Ponies 4 years and over. Riders any age over 5yrs.
- Max height of fences 80cm.

WORKING HUNTER / TRAINING STAKES CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd Prize Winners in classes 1-5 are invited to come forward to the championship

HORSE AND PONY SECTION – Indoor Arena

Will follow on from the Working Hunter section but will not commence before 12 noon

CLASS 6 INHAND HORSE & PONY

- Open to all types of horses & ponies, any age
- This class is not eligible for the Ridden Championship

CLASS 7 LEAD REIN

- Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over not exceeding 122cm, any type of pony
- Rider to be 3yrs and over and not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- The leading rein must be attached to the noseband and not the bit.
- Leaders must be 16 years old or over.

CLASS 8 TINY TOTS FIRST RIDDEN

- This class will be walk and trot only. There will be no change of rein on the go round.
- Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over not exceeding 128cm, any type of pony
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider who has attained their 4th birthday but not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- In the individual show, ponies will be expected to walk up and trot back, cantering is optional but no figure of eight or change of rein is required.
- No side, balance or grass reins are allowed

CLASS 9 FIRST RIDDEN

- This class will only have walk and trot on the go round. Cantering will be optional but only in the individual shows.
- Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over not exceeding 128cm, any type of pony
- Riders must be 5yrs and over and not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Ponies should leave the ring at walk or trot
- No side, balance or grass reins are allowed

CLASS 10 NEW COMBINATIONS PONY CLASS

- Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over. Up to 148cm. Any Type. Riders to be suitably mounted and any age above 5yrs.
- Combination to be within their first 12 months of partnership.

CLASS 11 NEW COMBINATIONS HORSE CLASS

- Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over. Exceeding 148cm. Any Type. Riders to be suitably mounted for the animal.
- Combination to be within their first 12 months of partnership

CLASS 12 NOVICE RIDDEN HORSE/PONY

- Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over. Any height, any type. Riders any age over 5yrs, suitably mounted

CLASS 13 OPEN RIDDEN HORSE/PONY

- Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over. Any height, any type. Riders any age over 5yrs, suitably mounted

CLASS 14 COLOURED RIDDEN HORSE/PONY

- Mare or Gelding 4yrs old or over. Any height, any type. Riders any age over 5yrs, suitably mounted
- If there are sufficient entries class will be split accordingly.

CLASS 15 PART BRED HORSE/PONY

- Mare or Gelding 4 yrs old or over. Any height, any type. Riders any age over 5yrs, suitably mounted

RIDDEN HORSE/PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd Prize winners in classes 7-15 are invited to come forward to the championship

Online & postal entries close on Monday 20th February at Midnight. Entries will also be taken on the day. Entry fees are non-refundable if the show must be cancelled due to weather conditions which are out with the control of the BSPS Scottish Branch. Entries are not transferable to other riders, ponies or classes. First Aid fees will apply.

Please note that all hats must comply with the following rule and must be hat tagged prior to entering the ring. Hat tagging will be available at the secretaries office on the day of the event. BSPS Scotland accepts no responsibility for any injury arising from a failure to comply with these rules.

HATS

43. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS 015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2016, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards. MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags)

BODY PROTECTORS

50. Body Protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes Including practice ring at B.S.P.S. Affiliated Shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes). Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organised and affiliated events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" with the year 2009 (Purple) or 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This Show is Affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
5. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
6. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. Cheques and Postal Orders to be made payable to BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd.
7. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted or amended once received.
8. Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd Show may use the arenas for exercising.
9. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground.
10. It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property.



Caledonian Showing Championships

This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which offers competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. With a draped main arena, amazing rosettes, special prizes, music, judges from the south and atmospheric Evening Performances, this is the show everyone wants to be part of

This year's show will be held at *Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 13/14/15 October 2023*

Every horse & pony placed 1st in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.
